







Ayushman Bharat - School Health and Wellness Programme (AB - SHWP): Towards health & well being of school children

Services provided through AB-SHWP



Under Ayushman Bharat: Ministry of Education and MoHFW jointly rolled out AB - SHWP to improve the health and wellbeing of school children. Two teachers in every school will be selected and trained as "Health and Wellness Ambassadors (HWA)"



AB - SHWP is a key intervention to link adolescents to essential health services



HWA will transact
weekly health
promotion and disease
prevention information
through interactive
activities with students





Adolescents who require further services are referred to Health and Wellness Centres (HWC) or nearest public health facility

Under Rastriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK), health screening is done for identification of 32 diseases with appropriate referrals



At schools across India, weekly Iron and Folic Acid (IFA) supplementation is provided to 6-19 year old students to prevent anaemia



During National Deworming Days, Albendazole tablets are administered to children at schools to eradicate intestinal worms



Sanitary napkins may be provided in the schools for adolescent girls as per Menstrual Hygiene Scheme (MHS) guidelines
