MoHFW trained the mentors from all States and UTs via online platform

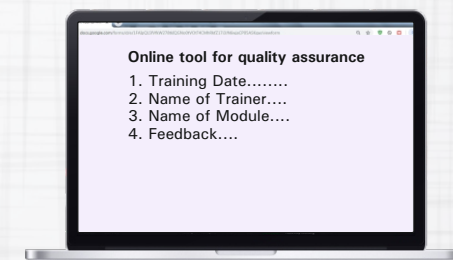


What will Mentors do?
